## 1. A SHORT PROFILE

This school is a co-educational institution from Pre-Nursery to Class X. This school was affiliated to CBSE, New Delhi in the year 1992 and was the first school in Cuttack to be affiliated to CBSE.

Joharimall High School, with strength of 600 plus has its own building, large & well ventilated Class Rooms, well trained and experienced faculties, well equipped Computer Lab with twenty(20) Computers, Mathematics & Science Lab.

This school has an excellent track record in its academic and co-curricular activities and gives prime importance to ethical, social attitudes and values, personality development, communication skills and emotional skills. National Talent Search Exam, Mathematics Olympiad, Science Olympiad, Tata Building India Essay Writing Competition and many other competitions organized by local clubs and organizations like YMCA, Rotary Club, Lion's Club of Cuttack, Marwari Yuva Manch etc. Geeta Chanting Competition is organized by Anuvrat, a Jain organization. Our main aim is to help students understand their strength and identify what skills they need to improve, to negotiate in a not-so-easy world by participating in various inter school competitions.
